



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FOR FUTURE PROJECT INITIATIVES

Whereas

- in December 2005 a Framework Programme Agreement for the realization of “Programme of Support to Regional Co-operation in the Balkan Countries” (hereinafter referred to as “APQ Balkans”) was stipulated with the Ministry of Economy and Finances (now Ministry of the Economic Development) and with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
 - the Line 2.4 Culture and Dialogue was called Integrated Project “Cultural Infrastructures & Territories” and was approved in December 2006;
 - the Apulia Regional Government is the leader government for the implementation of the IP “CIT”, that involves the Regional Governments of: Veneto, Emilia Romagna, Marche, Umbria, Abruzzo, Apulia, Calabria, Sicily. The foreign partners of the IP are Serbia, Montenegro, Albania, Macedonia and Bosnia-Herzegovina;
 - The partner of this IP CIT, after more than one year of its start, are interested to continue the strategic and operative cooperation, and for this reason they are organized a meeting in TIRANA the 18th of January 2011, where they are invited also other partner in international programme, to enhance the partnership.
1. The present memorandum of understanding is a result of the Integrated Project.
 2. To valorize the results and the best practices that in the IP were made, the partners decided to make new common activities
 3. Common activities may concern:
 - Promotion of new activities and initiatives aiming the protection, development and management of cultural heritage;

- Support in research and access to financial and material resources which promote investment in the cultural heritage in the countries involved;
 - Promotion of educational activities for the conservation, enhancement and management of cultural heritage, for theatral activities even if in organization of events
 - Design of innovative digital enviroments for cultural Heritage and museum education
 - Analisis of Microclimatics problem for Cultural Heritage
 - risk analisys and safety plane for Cultural Heritage
 - Sharing and exchanging information and good practice at international, national and local level relating to the sector, also using web gis and virtual tour.
 - Collaboration in fund raising at international, national and local level for activities development referred to above.
4. The partners will conduct or participate in national or international programs concerning the activities discussing during the working day in Tirana. will inform the network of such initiatives and share information that may be subject to interest.
 5. The partners also agree to disseminate the results of the foregoing and the future that will be realized.
 6. The partecipant to the working day in Tirana decided to set up a working group to prepare a new project to present to the next call in European Programme
